


CONTAINMENT BASIN FLOORS

SECONDARY CONTAINMENT SOLUTIONS

Corrosion-resistant fiberglass containment basin floors keep hazardous spills in controlled areas until they can be safely removed from the shelter.



CUSTOM SECONDARY CONTAINMENT SOLUTIONS

DESIGN YOUR SHELTER TO MEET YOUR NEEDS

SMALL AREA CONTAINMENT

Confine drips and minor leaks to designated areas located under equipment. For shelters housing multiple chemicals, add smaller containment areas to isolate liquids and keep them from mixing prior to removal.


LARGE AREA CONTAINMENT

A whole floor basin stores larger quantities of liquid for more significant spills and can be engineered to meet worst-case scenario volume.

Multiple room shelters can share a containment basin or be divided into smaller areas.

Remove fluids easily with a sump, a side wall drain, or a bottom drain.

A removable fiberglass grid surface provides a safe walking area over larger containment basins. The grating is supported by fiberglass stanchions that keep the walking surface above the storage basin and fluids, providing a safe space for technicians to work.
